Dues Reminder

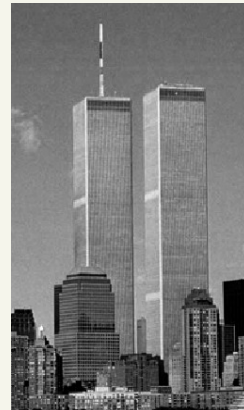
2017 dues collection is underway.
